WE DELIVER FISH FOR HERKIMER COUNTY RESIDENTS

If you are a Herkimer County resident, we will deliver the grass carp directly to your ponds immediately after our pick up on June 13th. Please use the reverse side of this form to draw a sketch map outlining directions to your pond. Please be specific, reference known landmarks such as intersections and public highways, and include the preferred vehicle access to the pond. This will enable our staff to locate your pond for stocking of the grass carp.

We will fill in the appropriate information at the bottom of the permit, forward one copy to NYS DEC, keep one copy for our records, and return the final copy to you when the fish are delivered/picked up.

What containers & water should I use? We recommend bringing one (1) 20-30 gallon plastic lined garbage can filled with your pond water only! Spring or well water is not recommended and chlorinated water is unacceptable! Containers must be clean. Copper or galvanized containers may be toxic to your fish. As an alternative, oxygen bagging is also available for \$1.00 per bag, to be paid directly to the fish supplier. A 5 gallon bucket works nice to place each bag of fish. Depending on your distance of travel, more than one grass carp may survive in a bag.

The Herkimer County Soil and Water Conservation District is not responsible for orders not picked up at the scheduled time or for the survival of these fish after you leave our office.

Herkimer County Residents – Delivery:

The Herkimer County Soil and Water Conservation District will not be responsible for any fish that perish after 24 hours from the time of delivery.
