***WHAT CONTAINERS & WATER SHOULD I USE?*** One (1) 30-gallon container for each 125 bass ordered and one (1) 30-gallon container for every 500 minnows ordered. A 30-gallon container works nicely for up to 75 of the 6 – 8” catfish. **Containers should be filled with your pond water only!** Spring or well water is not recommended and chlorinated water is unacceptable! Containers must be clean. Copper or galvanized containers may be toxic to your fish. As an alternative, oxygen bagging is also available for \$1.00 per bag, to be paid directly to the fish supplier, please remember to bring cash with you. A 5-gallon pail will hold one bag of fish.

**Recommended stocking rate is 100 – 125 bass per surface acre, and 500 – 600 minnows per surface acre as feeder fish. 6 – 8” Catfish stocking rate is 75 per surface acre.**

**NOTE:** A fish stocking permit OR farm fish pond license is required by NYS Environmental Conservation Law. The SWCD is no longer able to provide this service. Each landowner is required to obtain a stocking permit. Herkimer County is in DEC Region 6 but we can sell fish to any landowner regardless of what DEC Region their pond is in, as long as they have a fish stocking permit or farm fish pond license.
